General Information

How to select a school

This directory shows you where you are able to study in the rest of New Zealand other than Auckland, Wellington and Christchurch local government regions.

1. First consider the proximity of your residence to the particular location of a school, and how you would travel to get there.
2. Look at the different courses, and choose a course that best meets your needs. You may ring the Tertiary Education Commission (TEC) toll free Help Line 0800 601 301 to discuss course options with an English for Migrants Advisor.
3. Contact the school to find out more about their courses. Contact details are available in this directory. You may visit the school to help make your decision.
4. Some providers/schools facilitate home visiting tuition. However, it may cost extra, therefore please discuss your needs with the school administration.

Enrolling on a course

- Take a copy of your Agreement/Schedule (included in your settlement pack from New Zealand Immigration Service) to the school to show you have money available for tuition.
- When enrolling, you will be required to complete a Tertiary Education Commission Enrolment form/Tax Invoice (given to you by the school) to obtain payment for your course fees. Once you have signed, this document will be sent to the Tertiary Education Commission to deduct course fee from the money you have pre-paid.
- **Please check the course name and the amount of the fees before you sign the form.**

Refund & Withdrawal Policy

- A student can withdraw from a course within two weeks of enrolment. However, an administration cost may be charged. **In all other cases school's refund policy will apply.** Ask the school for a copy before you sign the enrolment form.
- If a refund is issued on your behalf, this will be sent to the Tertiary Education Commission and the money will be returned to your account.
