

WORKPLACE LITERACY FUNDING – TEO REPORTING INFORMATION

This exemplar provides information on the type of information TEOs should collect to report on the delivery of 2009/2010 Workplace Literacy provision. New data systems including the Literacy and Numeracy for Adults for Assessment Tool (the Assessment Tool) are rolling out in 2010. These should streamline the way that information is being collected. Some additional information to explain the data fields has also been provided.
