

## Am I eligible for Training Opportunities?

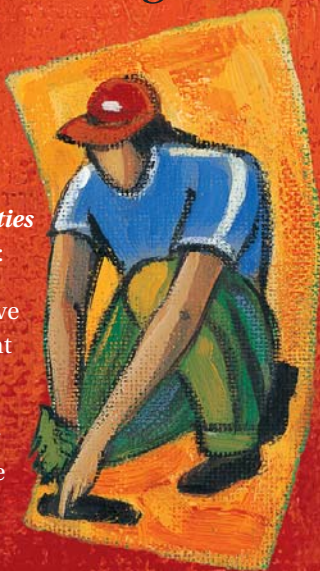
If you're over 18 years old, and unemployed, ask your nearest **Tertiary Education Commission** or **Work and Income** office if you can join.

**Training Opportunities** can help you to discover new possibilities and make more of skills you have. It will also assist you to gain national qualifications – our experience proves this gives you a better chance of getting a job. Training often takes place in small groups, at real workplaces. It's practical, hands-on, and helps you to achieve your employment goals.

## We pay for the cost of your training

**Training Opportunities** is fully subsidised, so you pay nothing. If you're on a **Training Opportunities** programme you also:

- continue to receive an unemployment benefit
- may be in line for a travel allowance to help you to get to your training programme.
