* **Note:** The Intensive Literacy and Numeracy fund provides support for intensive provision of quality literacy and numeracy learning delivered in an appropriate structured context with strong community links. Approximately \$13m will be allocated in 2010 to a university, schools, ITPs, PTEs, OTEPs and REAPs.

In 2009, approximately \$26 million is being invested in ACE outside of schools. This includes funding for community providers, universities, wānanga, ITPs, OTEPs and REAPs. Approximately the same amount will be invested in 2010.
