

Industry Training Project ITO/MAC Questionnaire Response Summary December 2009

Background

TEC has started work on building an Industry Training Register (ITR). This project aims to make reporting and data collection between ITOs, MACs, NZQA and TEC easier and more efficient.

To understand more about your systems, we contacted all ITOs in December 2009, asking your about your information systems, and plans for the next 12 months.

The information below is a summary of your responses.

Summary

30 Modern Apprenticeship Coordinators (MACs) and 38 ITOs were asked to send information about their systems. All the ITOs, and half the MACs responded.

Of those, all but two ITOs currently have an IT system to manage their student records. However there is a wide range of systems, with 18 separate systems being used across ITOs and MACs.

A number of organisations are planning to change or upgrade their systems, and a number are also already working with others, or planning to.

Additionally, 18 ITOs and MACs are planning on moving to a new system in the coming 12 months, and ten are already working in a cluster. Another 17 are looking into working with a cluster.
