Comparing PTEs may be difficult due to additional funding for some PTEs, and also the different sizes of PTEs.

The nature of enrolments at a specific PTE will influence its performance as well as the quality of the provision. For example, part-time and extra-mural students often have work or family commitments and cannot devote as much time and energy to their studies. They may also have different study goals.

An increase in enrolments in lengthy gualifications in 2011 may lower some TEOs' gualification completion rate


#### **Tertiary Education Strategy**
