February transition, Indicative Return (IND) and April SDR

SDR Transition

DXP Ngā Kete

Changes to SDR

- New look and feel and CSV file format
- Name of the CSVs files (see TEC website)
- New fields and changed validation rules (documented on page 8 in the data specifications)
- Ethnicity and Iwi codes align with NZ Stats
- Post codes align with NZ Post
- New SDR API submission option directly from SMS system (talk to your vendor)





Changes to Courses

- Course fee allow two decimal places
- Automated approval of total course cost (course tuition fees and Compulsory Course Cost (CCCost) if it is within the AMFM tolerance in the year.
 - Excluding micro-credentials and training scheme



SDR guidance

SDR guidance moves to the TEC website with a new page called SDR resources which includes:

- Data specifications
- Additional guidance for SDR submitters
- Course classification codes
- Generic enrolment form 2025 v2 (updated with learner IRD number)
