

DXP Ngā Kete SDR - what's changing (recap)

- New data requirements e.g. the new disability questions, additional ethnicity and iwi affiliation codes – required for the first time in August 2025 SDR
- Aligned reference data to current NZ Stats (iwi affiliation & ethnicity) and up to six values
- Automated approval of course tuition fees and CCCost if they are within the AMFM tolerance in the year.
- Rebuilt validation engine, updated some validation rules and re-wrote in plain English
- New API submission option directly from SMS system (optional)





Prep for transition – the SDR Pilot

- 18 early adopters (Pilot TEOs)
- Worked with Student Management Systems (SMS) vendors
 - At least One Pilot TEO for each vendor
- Pilot TEOs:
 - using DXP Ngā Kete registers
 - successfully submitted their August 2024 SDR in DXP Ngā Kete
 - will transition to the new registers, including AMFM change, in December
 - will submit their December SDR in DXP Ngā Kete
 - Some comments from Pilot TEOs.





SDR transition to DXP Ngā Kete



5pm, 21 February 2025 STEO access cutoff

22 to 23 February 2025 Register and SDR data migrated to DXP Ngā Kete

24 February 2025 SDR live in DXP Ngā Kete – use for March IND and April SDR

- Update to recent comm register data will be migrated 22 23 Feb, along with SDR data
- Any open course tuition fees and Compulsory Course Cost changes will be auto approved as part of migration if they are within the AMFM tolerance in the year.

Looking ahead to August 2025

- New data requirements are to be included for the first time in the August 2025 SDR
- This includes final-year Fees Free data, the new disability questions, additional ethnicity and iwi affiliation codes (if applicable) and reinstatement of the Apprenticeship flag (was "Managed Apprenticeships")
- An update to the Data specification for SDR will be published in May 2025 (ie v1.1)
