


The Challenges

Assessments

Assessments for this programme typically include short answer and multi-choice questions and some short written reports. There are no exams for this programme.

Some papers require a practical component as part of their assessment.

- » What sort of workload can I expect?
- As a guideline, one credit equates to approximately 10 hours of study. For example, a 15 credit paper equates
 to 150 hours of study. Spread over a 17 week intake, the average study time per week is approximately 9 hours.







