Some papers require a practical component as part of their assessment.

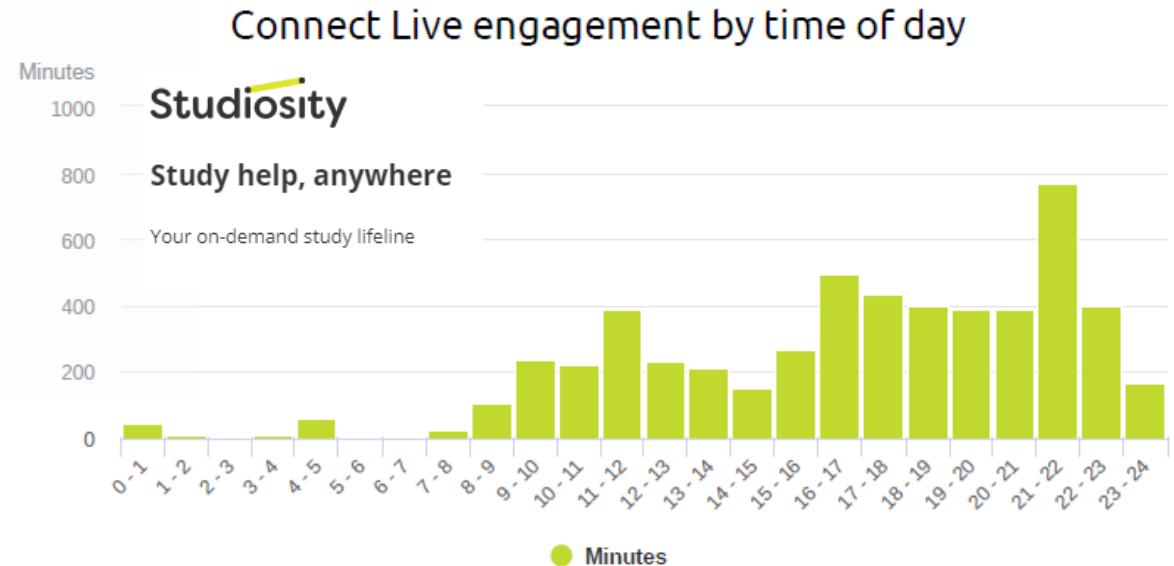
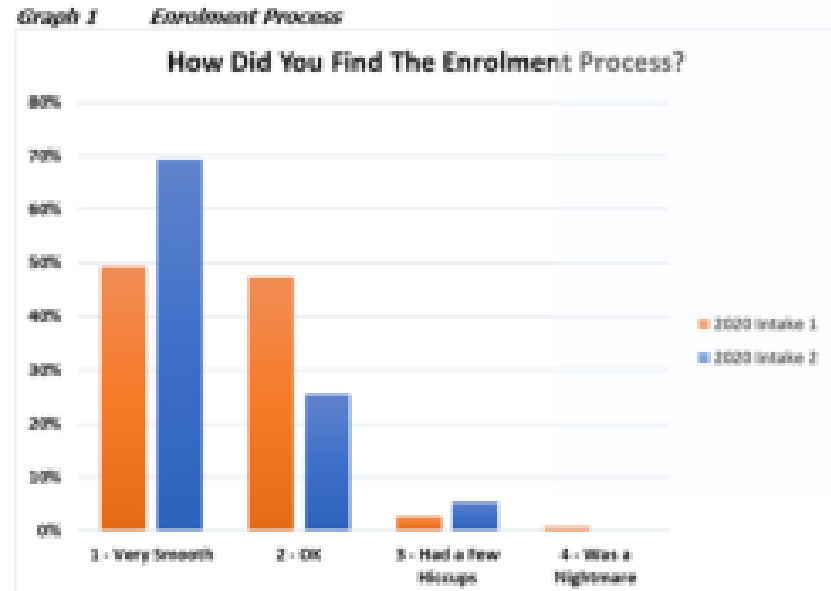
» What sort of workload can I expect?
