Tips for searching

- When you open the Fund finder it will by default show all funds. Using the filters and keyword searching removes funds from view that don't meet your search criteria.
- The Fund finder will remember your last search on your device, this includes filters, keywords, sorting and display options. To clear your last search use the 'Clear all filters' button underneath the filters.
- This is an 'AND' search. This means that adding the filters or keywords will narrow your search further.
- The Learner type filter will find funds that are exclusive to that Learner type. This does not mean the Learner type is ineligible for other funds.

For example searching by a Māori learner will find Māori and Pasifika Trades Training but these learners are also eligible for SAC3+

LAST UPDATED 21 JUNE 2017

The Student Achievement Component (SAC) is the Government's contribution towards the cost of teaching and learning services for students enrolled at a tertiary education organisation (TEO). Students must be studying towards a qualification listed on the [New Zealand Qualifications Framework \(NZQF\)](#).

The SAC comprises two funds; the SAC – Provision at Level 3 and above on the NZQF Fund (SAC level 3 and above), and the SAC – Qualifications at Levels 1 and 2 on the NZQF Fund. Information on these pages relates to SAC level 3 and above funding.

Information about SAC level 1 and 2 funding is available on the [SAC levels 1 and 2 competitive](#) and [SAC levels 1 and 2 non-competitive](#) webpages.

In addition see:

- SAC levels 3 and 4 (competitive) funding for information about this competitively allocated funding
- Equity funding for information about the Government's contribution to improve access to SAC-funded tertiary education for, and the achievement of, Māori students, Pasifika students, and students with disabilities
- Māori and Pasifika Trades Training (MPTT) funding for information about the Government's provision for fees-free SAC-funded tertiary education places for Māori and Pasifika students (to acquire the skills needed to enter into a New Zealand Apprenticeship or equivalent), and
