



# Quick Guide My Provision - ITR App

This app uses the Industry Training Register (ITR) enrolment data to provide a picture of who is enrolling in industry training and what they are enrolled in.

It shows detailed information for an individual organisation that submits data to the ITR. The detailed information is limited to authorised people within that organisation.

The information can be filtered by a range of filters, including reporting year, learner type and programme type. Information is shown by the number of learners, volume of delivery (STMs) and value of delivery (dollars GST exclusive).

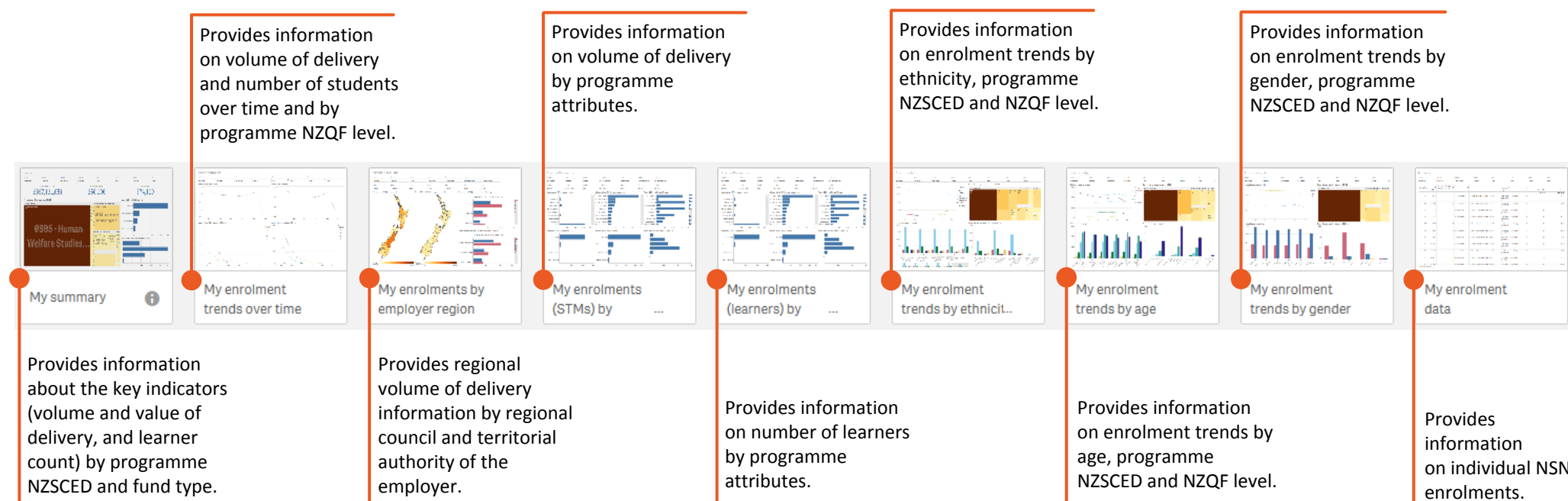
## Examples of what you can discover

- Trends in enrolments.
- Demographics of learners.
- The subject areas (NZSCED) in which learners are enrolled.
- Regions in which the learners are enrolled.

## Things to note

- Enrolment data is from 2011 onwards.
- If a learner has two or more ethnicities identified, they will be counted in each ethnicity. This means the total count by individual ethnicity may be greater than the total number of learners shown.
- Programme NZSCED, Age band, Programme group and Industry (ANZSIC) make use of the hierarchy: selecting one makes available the next level of the hierarchy.
- The data reflects the data in the ITR as at the end of the previous day.
- You can pan (traverse) and zoom in and out of the maps used in this app.
