National Certificate in Occupational Health and Safety (Workplace Safety) (Level 3)



Course Outline

The National Certificate in Occupational Health and Safety course (Level 3) requires a total of 50 credits that can be completed within a period of one year. The training involves a combination of both theory and practical application of skills and knowledge that can be used by a number of different industries.

The programme includes a compulsory section covering common health and safety skills and knowledge required by all industries and an elective section enabling different industries to choose standards, domains, or subfields that suit their requirements.

There is also a requirement that attendees apply their learning in a work environment around the particular subject areas. The overall course completion will take a minimum of 500 hours of blended learning and assessment. A log detailing the time involved in workplace application of skills is provided for the programme.

Participants completing this course will be able to progress on to the National Certificate in Occupational Health and Safety (Co-ordination) (Level 4) if they wish to become occupational safety facilitators.

Course Aim

This programme is designed to accommodate the needs of a wide cross section of industry personnel. The course is tailored for different industries to choose electives that suit the requirements of their industries.

Participants will develop or further develop common health and safety skills and knowledge required by all industries as well as enabling current employees of various industry organisations to up-skill and validate their 'on-job' knowledge of workplace health and safety practices. This will provide industry with workers who are well equipped to handle employer requirements to reduce the occurrence of incidents and injury in the workplace.
